We also welcome Father Shannon Thurman to our parish.

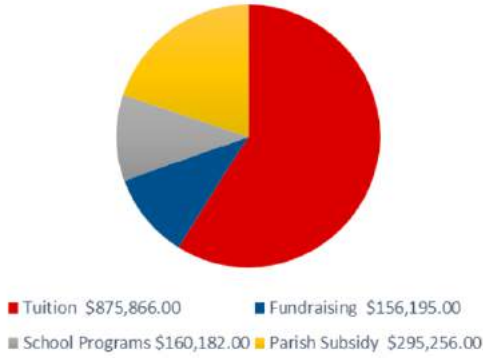

SOURCES OF FUNDS

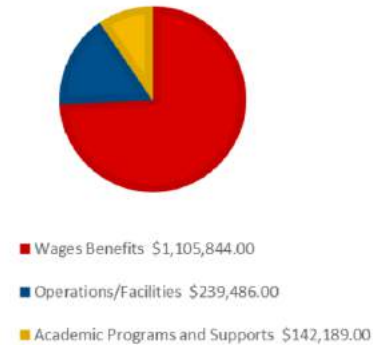


Tuition provides the majority of our revenue. However, the school is blessed with a dedicated PTO whose funds go towards the school. In addition, the school receives funds through tuition assistance, grants, and donations. Tuition for the first Catholic child in a family at SJE for kindergarten – 8th grade is \$5,775.00 and \$4,725 for additional children. The actual cost to educate a child at SJE for the 2021-2022 school year was \$9,659. As you notice, the difference between tuition and the actual cost is \$4,943.

We thank each of you who chaired, volunteered, attended an event, or donated to our school. Fundraising, grants, and donations are used to keep tuition as low as possible, provide campus improvements, and academic resources.

Your unwavering support safeguards SJE school's ability to offer the highest quality Catholic education. We believe the following information demonstrates our commitment to providing a Catholic faith-filled environment while engaging our learners and ensuring excellence in education through enhanced instruction and advanced technology.
